

DARS Fundraising Event Terms and Conditions for Friday December 17, 2021 at Mountain America Expo

Below is a list of important information and restrictions to help this event run safely and as smoothly as possible for all guests. Let's all do our part to make this a great evening!

Age restrictions:

Anyone 18 and older may attend. Some exceptions apply, but not without prior written permission from DARS.

Dress code: Dress clothes or casual dress is appropriate. Shoes-must be worn at all times.

Check-in

Your name and receipt that was Emailed to you when you purchased online from our event page will be the only method used for check-in. Please keep your Emailed receipt private. We will not be responsible for lost, wrongfully duplicated emails, or fraudulent activity.

If you purchase multiple tickets, your name will be listed with that number of guests. Purchasing online through DARS website is the only available option this event has currently.

Seating: 3 Halls (3, 4, 5)

The main seating in the dining halls are arranged in a banquet style that seats 10 people per table. Seating is done by the house but is on a first come first serve basis so please plan accordingly.

If multiple tickets are purchased at once from one person, we can try to accommodate seating arrangements at the same table for ten people. It will be the purchaser's responsibility to communicate to your other paid guests about your table's location.

If multiple tickets are purchased from one person but are not equivalent to 10 people, we reserve the right to complete seating guests at your table until full capacity is reached.

The main entertainment hall (middle hall) has limited row seating for anyone who may choose to be seated close to the live entertainment while performing later in the evening. These seats are on a first come first serve basis without a guarantee of single seating availability. Seating in this hall is only optional.

Tables or chairs with a "Reserved" display are for the use of staff only.

Dinner Menu:

A professionally catered dinner served buffet style along the inside perimeter of the dining halls will be provided by the company, Centerplate from 7pm-9pm. This Italian-style menu may vary in ingredients and may vary slightly in selection.

Buffet choices include:

*Tuscan pasta fagioli soup * Sliced rustic breads with rosemary oil * Caesar salad, grated Parmesan, garlic croutons, Caesar dressing * Heirloom tomatoes, basil pesto, local fresh mozzarella, wild arugula * Orzo pasta salad, toasted pine nuts, olive oil, lemon, wilted spinach, truffle oil * Cabernet braised beef short ribs, mushroom marsala * Tuscan style chicken breast * Sweet pea risotto, fried capers, lemon, herbs * Herb creamy mascarpone polenta * Roasted Italian vegetables ratatouille * Tiramisu, cannoli, amaretto * YUM!

Ticketing and Covid-Related information:

Tickets may not be resold, transferred or canceled under any circumstances. "No shows" are nonrefundable.

In the event we are required to limit the capacity of attendance and/or cancel the event due to Covid-related circumstances, the effort to reschedule the event program with either the same or reasonable/comparable entertainers for a later and for an undetermined date will be made first on DARS part for a period of 12 months. If after 12 months a rescheduled date cannot be coordinated, a refund in the full amount of the ticket originally paid will be granted to the original purchaser only and refunded to the same method of payment.

Prohibited items and additional terms in which may result in a person's immediate dismissal from the event:

Video recordings of any kind are strictly prohibited without prior written consent from DARS and will be confiscated immediately. No weapons of any kind in or around the premises. We reserve the right to check for weapons. Alcohol is strictly prohibited. All outside food and drinks are prohibited. Lasers and other bright or distracting lights are not permitted from guests. Smoking including vaping is prohibited indoors and all guests must comply with Utah Clean Air act (UICAA)

We reserve the right to refuse admission or restrict full attendance of any person who may pose as a disruption to any staff member or guest. No refunds will be granted.

Sensitive subject matter and trigger warning:

This event contains sensitive subject matter displayed around the venue and verbally expressed throughout the evening pertaining to abuse, violence, neglect, mental illness, suicide, in addition to other potentially sensitive subjects.

Flashing lights and controlled pyrotechnics will be present.
